It is more important that you learn the required skills and are comfortable with leading a group of people following safe and ethical guidelines.

To give you an idea of what is required to become a Road Captain:

- Be a Winnipesaukee Chapter Member in good standing for a period of one (1) year, or have previous experience as a trained Road Captain
- Participate in a minimum of three chapter rides
- Complete Winnipesaukee HOG Road Captain Training
- Shadow the Lead RC for one Winni HOG Ride
- Satisfactorily assist on a chapter ride as "Sweep RC" (prior approval of Head Road Captain is required) while shadowing an experienced RC assigned as sweep for that ride
- Satisfactorily plan and lead one (1) ride under the supervision of the Head Road Captain (or his/her designee) and perform adequately (in the opinion of the trainer) in all aspects of the Winni HOG RC SOP
- RECOMMENDED (Not required) Training NH State Experienced Rider Class (ERC) or equivalent, Accident Scene Management Class, American Red Cross First Aid/CPR/AED Certification
